Mission Statement

The Rutgers Lacrosse Camp is part of the MVP Lacrosse Camps, LLC. For the past 20 years, MVP has run teaching camps across the country. This is accomplished in a fun-filled and exciting atmosphere at one of the top lacrosse facilities in the nation.

Location

Rutgers University is conveniently located between Long Island, Philadelphia & Baltimore, off Exit 9 on the New Jersey Turnpike.

Facilities

- Rutgers University has some of the top athletic facilities in the country
- Eight full lacrosse fields including the turf stadium and indoor bubble
- Air-conditioned, suite- style rooms that sleep six in doubles
- Camp store – pizza, snacks, drinks and lacrosse apparel

Registration

Registration will be held from approximately 3pm-6pm on the first day of camp. Camp will conclude at 3:00 p.m. on the final day. Games will be played on the last afternoon beginning at 1:00 p.m. Parents are welcome to attend.

What to Bring

Bed sheets and blanket for a single bed, or a sleeping bag. Pillows, towels and toiletries. Campers need a full set of lacrosse equipment including: mouthpiece, turf and grass shoes. (Equipment will not be provided)

Instruction

The camper to staff ratio is 9-1 to ensure small group instruction. All coaches stay in the dorms and are easily accessible. The campers have three mandatory sessions daily and evenings are filled with lacrosse films.

Participant Code of Conduct

MVP Lacrosse Camp is dedicated to providing its participants with a quality lacrosse experience that combines the highest level of instruction with the opportunity to participate and compete in games against players from other areas. In its efforts, MVP Lacrosse Camp is committed to preserving the honor of the game and the true spirit of instruction and competition.

To help fulfill its mission, MVP Lacrosse Camp expects that all participants (campers, as well as family, friends and fans in attendance) abide by a Code of Conduct. Failure to do so may result in immediate expulsion from the camp without compensation or refund.

1. Participants are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that honors the game and demonstrates respect for other players, coaches, officials and spectators.
2. Performing, permitting, encouraging, or condoning actions that are dangerous or demeaning to a player, coach, official or spectator is unacceptable.
3. Participants are not permitted to be in the possession of or under the influence of alcohol, drugs, and/or tobacco products.
4. Participants are not permitted to be in the possession of weapons.
5. Participants are expected to wear all of the necessary and required equipment for participation in lacrosse.
6. Participants are expected to report any and all injuries to a member of the camp medical staff.
7. Participants are expected to treat all MVP Lacrosse Camp facilities with respect. The camp will not tolerate any acts of vandalism or actions that result in damage to property. MVP Lacrosse Camp will hold participants legally and financially responsible for any and all damages they may cause to the property or facilities of MVP Lacrosse Camp including, but not limited to, Rutgers University, and all fields and facilities used by MVP Lacrosse Camp.

Participant Waiver & Release Signature Is Required to Participate
